

Guidelines for issuing Permit to Solicit

1. Applicant must complete a sworn written application as provided by the Village Clerk.
 - A. Such application must be accompanied by a readable copy of the applicant's drivers' license.
 - B. If several agents will be peddling, soliciting or distributing merchandise or printed materials, each agent shall be registered separately and each shall pay the appropriate fee of \$50.00 per individual agent.
 - C. If solicitor will be asking for monetary payments at the time of his sales visit, the solicitor shall be required to provide a Security Bond or Cash in the amount of \$1,500.
2. Once completed the above application(s) shall be presented to the Caledonia Village Police Department for review and approval.
3. Once the Caledonia Village Police Department approval has been granted the Clerk will collect the specified fees and issue the Permit(s). The Permit is good for one calendar year. A copy of all paperwork shall be retained for village records.
4. Surety in the form of bond or cash deposit shall be held in full force and effect for 90 days following termination of activity within the village.
