Countless hours of studying was conducted prior to a decision being made concerning the purchase of apparatus and other equipment. There will be a 0% tax increase with the use of equipment reserve funds. A public hearing will be held on October 9th at 7 p.m. at the Town Hall. The vote will be held on October 23rd, 6-9 p.m. at the Town hall.
